Matthew 13 There are <u>7 parables</u> in this chapter referred to as "The Parables of The Kingdom."

"Parable"- is made up of two words Para – "alongside" Ballo – "to throw or cast" Parable – "To cast alongside."

We will look at 4 areas in our study:

- 4. Verses 51-52 The Disciple:

1. Verse - 44 The Treasure:

We need to note that these 3 final parables were addressed exclusively to the disciples. Matthew 13:36

Exclusively in <u>Matthew's Gospel</u> the term "The Kingdom of Heaven" – Refers to saved and unsaved people.

Exclusively in <u>Matthew's Gospel</u> the term "The Kingdom of God" – Refers to saved people never unsaved people.

The Common Interpretation is:

This goes against everything the Bible says: The sinner cannot "find Christ" for he is blind and stubborn (Romans 3:10). It is the Savior who finds the lost sinner (Luke 19:10).

The gift of God. Found and hid; we are told not to hide the light or hide Jesus or the message.

2. Verses - 45-46 The Pearl:

The Common Interpretation is:

Is like a merchant - Jesus Christ

Seeking fine pearls, The Believers, Gentiles, and Jews that make up the Church.

The Focus of this Parable is - The focus is upon Jesus the master merchant. Who misses nothing!

3. Verses - 47-50 The Net:

Dragnet – The net of the gospel of the Kingdom of heaven that attracts and gathers so many people.

The sea, the sea of humanity (People).

Shore – The end of the age at the Second Coming of Jesus Christ.

Judgment - "to separate, to divide, to make distinctions"

The Focus of this Parable is – God is in control over His kingdom and He will divide the good from the bad. God wins!

4. Verses - 51-52 The Disciple:

Christianity is to be Understood and Experienced: "Have you understood all these things?"

We must be scribes who discover the truth:

We must be disciples who do the truth: who has become a disciple of the kingdom of heaven

We must be stewards who dispense the truth: who brings forth out of his treasure things new and old."

Application:

Sower and the seed – Not all crowds are genuine.

Wheat and Tares – When there is a true work of God get ready for Satan to disrupt.

Mustard Seed – False growth, don't look at elevated size and numbers instead look for character.

Leaven – False doctrine

Treasure – The love God has for Israel.

Pearl – He is the master merchant the love God has for the Church.

Dragnet – The Lord is in control that He will have His way.
