Any person's thinking that says, "Religion is relative, and any sincere faith and practice will do!" That person needs to read Matthew 23; Mark 12:38-40

The Setting is "The Passion Week". It is the last week of Jesus' earthly ministry. "The Week That Changed The World"

Rebuking The Scribes – Matthew 23:6-7,14; Mark 12:38-40; Luke 20:45-47

The Widow's Giving – Mark 12:41-44; Luke 21:1-4

The Thought Of Our Passage: Disciples Of Jesus Must Be On Guard Against Spiritual Hypocrisy; What Man Congratulates, God Often Condemns.

<u>1. Verses 38-40 – Spiritual Pretenders</u> <u>2. Verses 41-44 – Spiritual Casualties</u>

1. Verses 38-40 – Spiritual Pretenders:

Mark 12:38

"And in His teaching He was saying" – The word "teaching" K.J.V. says "Doctrine", which is simply teaching; systematic teaching.

Mark 12:37

Luke 20:45

"Beware of the scribes" – When you have to beware of your protectors, you're in trouble. (Matthew 23)

Jesus is saying, "Protect yourself against your protectors!"

Jesus Is Warning against <u>Conduct and Practices</u> but also against <u>The Persons</u> who are given to such conduct and practices.

What Characterizes Their False Virtue? It's merely external.

"scribes" – Also known as Lawyers, Experts of the Law. They were Pharisees. (Scribes laid out the demands and the Pharisees enforced them.)

6 Warnings Against Hypocrisy In Conduct and Practice:

1. Spiritual Hypocrisy In Their Apparel: "who like to walk around in long robes,"

Matthew 23:5 - "and lengthen the tassels of their garments."

Lesson: They confused cloths for character and content.

 Spiritual Hypocrisy In Wanting The Respect/Recognition Of Man: "and like respectful greetings in the market places," Luke 20:46 – "love respectful greetings in the market places,"

Matthew 23:8-10

Rabbi – "O great one, O knowledgeable one, O excellent one, O exalted teacher."

Let us never forget that the term "Minister" means "Servant".

Satan Wanted Worship; Fallen Human Nature tendency is to receive human honor.

John 5:44

Lesson: False teachers are never humble. They always need to be elevated: They confused respect and honor for a mark of greatness.

Mark 12:39

3. Spiritual Hypocrisy In Wanting Chief Seats: "and chief seats in the synagogues,"

Lesson: They wanted the focus and the attention to be upon them: We should want the attention to go to the Lord, not self.

 Spiritual Hypocrisy In Loving Pre-eminence: "and places of honor at banquets," Matt 23:6 – "And <u>they love</u> the place of honor at banquets,"

To the Scribes, success meant recognition & praise by men.

Where a man sits bears no relationship to what a man is.

Luke 22:24

Lesson: There should be no greater aspiration than being that of a servant of God: Greatness is serving others, not being served by others.

Mark 12:40

 Spiritual Hypocrisy In Loving Money: "who devour widows' houses," – "devour": "to plunder them, literally to eat them up"

Lesson: The depraved minded and deprived of the truth, see money in ministry: 1 Timothy 6:5

 Spiritual Hypocrisy In Using Religion As A Front: "and for appearance's sake offer long prayers;" – "a show, an outward showing, to pretend, under color" Matt 23:14

Lesson: God's Judgment Will Fall Upon Religious Impostors: "these will receive greater condemnation." – Literally "abundant judgment, more judgment."

2. Verses 41-44 – Spiritual Casualties:

Mark 12:41

"And He sat down opposite the treasury," – compound word – "treasure" and "guard"; literally "a safe place for gifts."

"observing" – Greek word in English "Theater"; "to look with interest, to look with perception, thoughtful observation."

Matthew 6:1-4

Mark 12:42

Mark 12:40 - "who devour widows' houses,"

"copper coins" – Mites, which meant – "thin and small coin"; They were worth about 1/4 or 1/5 of a cent.

Mark 12:43

1 Corinthians 13:3

2 Cor. 9:7

Mark 12:44

Lesson – God's Method of Computing Values Is Different From Man's: "but she, out of her poverty, put in all she owned, all she had to live on." (Not the amount given but the amount left!)

True Givers are given a promise: 2 Cor 8:15

- 1. Spiritual Hypocrisy Is Hated By God, Because God Is Opposed To The Proud But Gives Grace To The Humble.
- 2. God Does Not Want Our Money. He Wants Us. Yet We Cannot Give Ourselves To Him Apart From Our Money.
- 3. It Is True That Money Speaks; It Tells Us Where Our Hearts Are.
