John 8:32

Most people define Freedom as: **Freedom –** "being able to do whatever you feel like doing."

John 8:34 – "everyone who commits sin is the slave of sin."

The true definition of **freedom** is, "being able to be all that you were created to be." **Jesus is the source of spiritual freedom!**

John 8:12-30 – Jesus Teaching In The Temple. John 8:31-47 – Jesus' Instruction To Professing Believers. John 8:48-59 – The Response Of The Unbelievers.

Thought Of Our Passage: "Real Freedom Comes Through Faith In Jesus, Who Frees Us To Become What God Created Us To Be."

<u>1. Verses 31-32 – The Way To Freedom</u> <u>2. Verses 33-34 – The Fraud Of Freedom</u> <u>3. Verses 35-36 – The Promise Of Freedom</u>

1. Verses 31-32 – The Way To Freedom:

John 8:31

"So Jesus was saying" – What was Jesus saying? Takes us back to John 8:30.

John 8:12-30 – Jesus is the guiding light and the Warning light. Jesus revealed Himself as the light of the world. John 8:24

John 8:28-30

John 8:31-47 – Jesus' Instruction To Professing Believers.

Verse 31 – Freedom Begins With Believing In Jesus: "to those <u>Jews who</u> <u>had believed Him</u>," – "believed Him" – "a reliance upon, to cling to, that stays, to stay with"; Genuine Faith – We need to confess that we are paralyzed in our sins; That we are in a condition that no man can do; only the intervention of God will do! Belief Begins With Knowledge – The intellectual facts, evidence about salvation.

John 20:31

Belief Agrees – that the facts of Jesus and salvation are true.

Belief Trusts – and acts on them by personally trusting Jesus as the hope of our salvation.

Verse 31 – Freedom Is Continuing In The Word: "If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine;"

"If you continue in My word" – The Greek implies "It is doubtful that you will." "Your persistent loyalty to the truth I have taught you will prove the reality of your present profession."

Matthew 12:50

John 15:14

John 17:17

Disciple – "learner, a follower of the teacher and his teaching." There is such a thing as being a disciple in name only. John the Baptist preached repentance and expected change – Matthew 3:7-8.

Continuance in Jesus' teaching is the acid test of regenerating faith!

Matthew 13:20-21

1 John 2:19

Verse 32 – Freedom Is Knowing The Truth: John 8:32.

"and you will know the truth," – The blessing of believing in Jesus and continuing to obey His Word is to know the truth.

John 7:17

Know – This word appears 56X in the gospel of John. It speaks of a "Knowledge that is gained from experience." Here is a progress from ignorance to knowledge; Note, "you will know."

"the truth" – is "formulated, revealed reality." Which finds its center in the reality of Jesus Christ. The truth is a person – John 14:6.

What, then, is the truth? Truth is the nature of things as they really are. Verse 32 – Freedom Is Being Made Free: "the truth will make you free." – The word "free" – This is a word that is used only here in John 8:32, 33, 36. It means "absence of constraint and restriction, opportunity to exercise the right of acting apart from external interference," John 8:34; "free" was used in the first century in the releasing of a slave. Here it is spiritual/moral slavery.

To be free comes from, "<u>If you continue in My word</u>, then you are truly disciples of Mine;" – You can know truth and freedom and still not be free.

Luke 4:18

Fear Is A Thief Of Freedom.

Anger Is A Thief Of Freedom.

Guilt Is A Thief Of Freedom.

2. Verses 33-34 – The Fraud Of Freedom:

John 8:33

False Freedom – Ancestry And National Privilege: "They answered Him, 'We are Abraham's descendants'"

Spiritually Blind – We Don't Need Liberation: "and have never yet been enslaved to anyone;"

"have never yet been enslaved to anyone;" – This Is A Lie! Pride is blind to the truth.

John 8:34

"Truly, truly, I say to you," – This is the truth, this is a true saying, listen up!

"everyone who commits sin" – "living a life of sin" is the slave of sin.

"Slavery is not inflicted from without but from within."

John 5:6

John 3:19-21

3. Verses 35-36 – The Promise Of Freedom:

John 8:35

These Jews were slaves to sin, they did not have access to heaven, to God, the Father's house as they have imagined.

John 8:36

"So if the \underline{Son} " – This is Jesus claiming to be Deity; "makes you free," – He has the authority to forgive sins (Debt of sin).

"makes you free," – This freedom is the result of faith in Him, the son of God; That He releases us from the bondage of sin.

"you will be free indeed." - It means "really free"; Only used here in John.

Galatians 4:4-7

Application:

- 1. Believing In Jesus, Obeying His Word, And Knowing The Truth Will Bring Spiritual Freedom.
- 2. God's True Freedom Is To Choose That Which Is Right, The Freedom To Choose The Best, The Freedom To Keep On Growing, The Freedom To Reach Our God-Given Potential, This Is Free Indeed.
