#### 1. Verses 47-50 – The Kiss of Judas:

with swords (Roman soldiers) and clubs, (hired as temple police)

Matt 26:48

kiss - "that of a friend, associate, neighbor"

Matt 26:49

"Hail, Rabbi!" Judas gives a common greeting: "be well, be glad, God speed, greetings Teacher!"

kissed - the Greek word here is different from Verse 48, the common greeting type kiss; speaks of a "passionate kiss repeatedly, to kiss affectionately" "To kiss again and again, tenderly."

"Friend, – this term this is not an endearing term, literally "Associate"; used as a rebuke – do what you have come for."

Hypocrite – Ho-po-creat, "to speak from under"; The Greek actors spoke from under a mask.

having a sword, which was a "large dagger, a large knife."

legions – is about 6,000 soldiers. twelve legions of angels this would be 72,000 angels.
