### 1. Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – The greatest in the kingdom will stoop to serve the least:

Matt 20:30

All 3 Gospels record this event: Matt 20:29-34; Mark 10:46-52; Luke 18:35-43

Gerasenes - Matthew 8:28-34; Luke 8:26-39; Mark 5:1-20

### 2. Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – Don't get so bogged down in details that we fail to see those that sought Jesus in faith and found Him:

Mark 10:46 a blind beggar

## **3.** Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – We are poor, spiritual beggars who have no hope of improving our condition and have no claim on Jesus:

Blindness in Jesus day carried a stigma:

John 9:1-3

Blindness is a symbol of spiritual ignorance and unbelief:

Isaiah 6:10

Matt. 6:22-23

# 4. Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – These two blind men were physical illustrations of the disciples' spiritual blindness:

Mark 10:46

Bartimaeus - Means "Son of Timaeus." Timaeus - "Unclean" so his name is "Son of the Unclean." Foul in a religious sense, defiled, infamous, polluted"

### 5. Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – When our meeting with Jesus comes, we need to take it; it's now or never:

Acts 17:32

Mercy – compassion for the consequences of sin "not giving what is deserved"

The principal Hebrew word for mercy – (compassion) speaks of "an emotional response to the needs of others. It means to feel the pain of another so deeply that we're compelled to do something about it."

### 6. Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – When we approach God, we must come appealing for mercy; God is the God of all mercy!:

### 7. Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – Faith can be found in the most unlikely places; The Revelation of the blind:

# 8. Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – The crowd will not help us, because the crowd is also blind:

These are men who will not be kept from Christ who in the end find him.

# 9. Great Lessons In Meeting Jesus – These two blind men were not afraid to bring a great request:

Matt 20:34

Webster's defines compassion as " feeling of deep sympathy and sorrow for someone in the midst of a tragedy, accompanied by a desire to alleviate the suffering."

#### **Application:**

- 1. We will never truly seek God until we are willing to admit our inability to help ourselves:
- 2. In seeking a relationship with God we must approach God only on the basis of His mercy:
- 3. We are not to allow anything to keep us or hinder us from our pursuit of God: Family, friends or crowds.
- 4. What is it that we would want Jesus to do for us? Do we truly want to be made whole?
- 5. If a person says they are in the light (can see) and are walking in darkness (walking in sin), they are deceived. How can a person that has had their eyes opened continue to live in darkness?
