The Gospel of Mark records, a typical day in the life of Jesus Christ:

Gospel's of Matthew, Luke, and John focus more on the <u>Words</u> of Jesus. Mark focuses more on the <u>Works</u> of Jesus.

The word <u>immediately</u> is the key word in Mark, used 49X. In our passage it is used 4X

Mark 1:14-9:50 - Jesus' Galilean Ministry

The Thought Of Our Passage: "God's Servant Immediately Meets Man's Physical Need, But Man's Greatest Need Is Met In The Gospel, God's Forgiveness"

1. Verses 21-28 – Morning – Ministry In The Synagogue:

Mark 1:21

Verses 16-20 – Jesus started His Saturday with the calling of Peter, Andrew, James and John to discipleship.

(<u>Pictures</u>) Capernaum – City on the Northwest shore of the Sea of Galilee. It became the headquarters of Jesus' ministry. Matthew 9:1

Matthew 11:23

Synagogue – The synagogue came into being when Israel was cast into Babylon captivity.

"began to teach." Mark 1:14

Verse 22 – Jesus Teaching With Authority: Mark 1:22

"amazed" – "astonished, to be struck in the head, strike a person out of their senses, to shock"

"scribes" – were called Lawyers; they were experts of the Law.

Scribes Spoke From The Authorities, Jesus Spoke With Authority.

1 Peter 4:11

Verses 23-28 – Jesus' Power Over Demons: Mark 1:23

"unclean spirit;" — "Demonized", a person under the control of a demon or demons. Unclean — speaks of "character, morality and even physically"

Luke 11:21-26

Don't base doctrine off experience then find scripture to support it. Base doctrine on the Word of God and let experience fall where it may.

Mark 1:24

The Demon Wanted Jesus To Leave – "What do we have to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth?" Or, "You have no business with us yet"

The Question of Judgment – "Have You come to destroy us?"

2 Peter 3:3-4

Revelation 20 – Speaks of God's final judgment, the lake of fire forever.

The Demon Knew Jesus' Identity – "I know who You are – the Holy One of God!"

Mark 1:25

"Be quiet," - "be muzzled"

"and come out of him!" – Jesus not only had a <u>message of authority</u> but <u>actions of authority.</u>

Mark 1:26

Acts 19:13-16

Spiritual Warfare Must Be Waged Spiritually Not Physically! By God's People, In God's Way, For God's Glory!

Mark 1:27-28

Miracle showed that Jesus <u>spoke</u> and then <u>produced</u> the message in service.

2. Verses 29-31 – Noon – Visitation And Healing:

Mark 1:29

That is a good thing to do, to take Jesus home with us. Don't leave Him at Church!

Mark 1:30

"a fever;" – "burning" Exodus 15:26

Matt 8:14 – He saw his mother-in-law lying sick in bed with a fever.

Mark 1:30 – and immediately they spoke to Him about her.

Luke 4:38 – and they made request of Him on her behalf.

The home of the minister, the servant of God is not exempt from suffering and hardships.

Mark 1:31

"and she waited on them." – (Saved To Serve)

3. Verses 32-34 – Evening – Ministry To A Crowd:

Mark 1:32

"they began bringing," - Literally "they kept on bringing"

"all who were <u>ill</u> and those who were <u>demon-possessed</u>." – Notice that the Bible makes a distinction between <u>ill</u> and <u>demon-possessed</u>.

Mark 1:33-34

Matt 8:17 – Matthew quotes is from Isaiah 53:4

4. Verses 35-39 - Morning - Meeting With His Father:

Mark 1:35

"early morning, while it was still dark," - Literally "very early by night"

Matthew 6:6 – called it your "Inner room."

"praying" – "word for true worship, the soul moving out towards God"

Mark 1:36 – hunted for Him; Literally "hunted Him down"

Mark 1:37-38 – "and they found Him, and said to Him, 'Everyone is looking for You.'"

"what I came out for." – Literally, "That Is Why Jesus Came" (Incarnation)

Mark 1:39

Application:

- 1. The Scribes Spoke From The Authorities, Jesus Spoke With Authority. Beware Of Mere Human Intellect That Masquerades As Religious, But Is Void Of A Relationship With God.
- 2. Jesus Was Aware Of Peter's Mother-in-law's Sickness, But The Disciples Still Bought Their Cares To Jesus.
- 3. Peter's Mother-in-laws Response To Jesus' Touch Was Spiritual; It Was To Serve Him.
- 4. Man's Greatest Need Is Not Physical But Spiritual, Which Is Met Through The Preaching Of The Gospel, The Forgiveness Of Our Sins.
